


Advices to help your child to speak

Spend time with your child

(what does it mean)??

- ★ Look at him, listen to him and give him attention.
- ★ Involve him in daily life activities (dressing, shopping, bus, playground) by playing and talking with your child.
- ★ When you play, use environmental sounds and animal sounds.
- ★ Sing little songs together.



Opportunity for choice

★ Help him communicate his desires.

- ◆ remove distractions from the environment. 
- ◆ ask him to choose between two objects (two games, two snacks foods, two books).
- ◆ give him the time he needs and don't rush him.



Pretend to play



Symbolic play promotes language development.

- ★ Feed the puppets, put the dolls on grandma, pretend to cook.
- ★ Use one object to make it become another (a marker as a phone as a horse).

Listen and use what he says to broad and enrich his communication. Use a suitable language

- ★ Don't correct him or ask his to repeat your model.
- ★ Encourage him and always reinforce his production (with the words "well done", and with facial expressions such as smiling at him).
